

Minutes of Cedarville Village Council

Held June 24, 2019

Council met in regular session on June 24, 2019 with President Pro-Tem Terrell presiding due to Mayor's absence. Council members present were Brooks, Chisholm, Dawes, Stancliff, Terrell and Ware. Councilmember Brooks recorded the minutes.

Minutes: Minutes of the June 10, 2019 meeting were accepted as submitted.

Mayor Pergram: Excused (General Updates provided)

- Mr. Jim Phipps and Mayor Pergram are working on the flood-plain survey regarding the new police department.
- Grace Baptist Church of Cedarville is now opening their tornado shelter for the public any time there is a Tornado Watch or higher alert. This will be in rooms 121 and 122 which hold 100 and 200 people, respectively. There are also two (2) restrooms at this level that could hold an additional 30-40 people in an emergency. Entrance can be from the gym/carport entrance or the entrance off Cedar St.

Police Chief Combs:

- Discussion regarding the Chief using a cruiser, i.e. keeping at his house.

Mr. Dawes moved and Mr. Chisholm seconded to allow the Chief to keep a cruiser at his house at his discretion. Note: This is designed to ensure a quick response in an emergency, but only applies to the current chief. Motion passed with all ayes.

- Received report that foxes are living in a house at 57 W. Elm St. Ginger will send letter to the owner.
- Cell phones have been obtained for the police force for use for police department business only. The number for the on-duty officer is: 937-657-1121.

Village Administrator Furay:

- Currently working on the restrooms at the Community Park.
- Department is in need of some new mowing equipment.
- Greene County landfill inspection and compost inspection have been completed and we are awaiting the reports.
- Crosswalk and parking spot painting will be completed soon.
