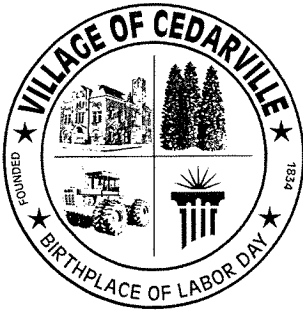

## ORDINANCE 2023 - 09

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE TO REFER DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR CERTIFICATION TO REAL ESTATE TAXES OF THE DELINQUENT DEBTOR.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Village Council that the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Cedarville has made numerous attempts to collect on a number of delinquent accounts receivable resulting from services provided by the Village to certain residents of the Village and all such efforts taken by the Fiscal Officer have be unsuccessful, and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has requested that he be given authority to refer such delinquent accounts receivable to the Greene County Auditor for certification to the real estate taxes of the delinquent debtors, and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Village Council that such a request by the Fiscal Officer is not only reasonable but also a fiscal responsible position for the Village to take, therefore


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CEDARVILLE, OHIO,

Section One: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village be authorized to refer delinquent accounts receivable, in the amount of **\$2,700.00**, to the Greene County Auditor for certification to the real estate taxes of delinquent debtors after reasonable attempts on the part of the Fiscal Officer to collect on said delinquent accounts have been unsuccessful.

Section Two: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
